Institutions

- SEMANAH: institution responsible for the application of MARPOL Convention, Annex VI, through the Maritime Safety Directorate (DSM) for the application of Port State Control and the Directorate of Marine Environment Protection (DPMM) for laboratory analysis.
 - Haiti has signed the MARPOL Convention but not yet ratified.
- National Port Authority (APN),
- Haitian Coast Guard
- Ministry of Environment

Legislation

- New organic law of September 2017 of reorganization of SEMANAH replacing the decree of March 1982,
- New maritime code in September 2017.
- Ratification of MARPOL: High level MARPOL mission to the Haitian Government and Parliament to activate the ratification process of MARPOL Convention.

Monitoring and enforcement measures (MARPOL Annex VI)

- Penalties for polluters provided for in the new maritime code.
